## KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS AND JOB DESCRIPTION

- Plan, organise, direct, delegate, control and monitor all aspects of depot operations
- Engage with internal and external stakeholders such as City of Ekurhuleni (CoE), Busmark, etc on a regular basis to report on the general state of the operations and any other issues that may be identified on an ongoing basis.
- Manage SLA's and participate in relevant Supply Chain processes.
- Check the general state and synergies of bus schedules and dispatch to suggest possible solutions and/or improvements to the service.
- Liaise with Supervisors daily to ensure that all accidents/damages or health hazards are reported immediately and in line with the policies.
- Resolve complex queries escalated by Line Supervisors.
- Engage with Security Company and Supervisors to ensure that the depot and movable assets are secure at night.
- Manage the bus operations objectives through communication, surveys and monitoring performance to ensure correct service delivery.
- Manage costs and productivity within the operation to ensure that operating efficiency and cost effectiveness are met. E.g. Reduction of operating cost per bus, improved accuracy of data pertaining to number of passengers and revenue collected, etc.
- Consolidate and customize all reports in line with the specific target audience such as the CoE, COO and other external stakeholders that may request the information from time to time.
- Work with the COO on the Operations budget allocated to ensure that it is aligned to the current operational needs.
- Identify opportunities and risks within the operation that may impact the operation and ability to deliver commitments.
- Manage people's performance and growth.
- Direct and harness the efforts of depot staff through communication and team building initiatives.
- Issue directions in any emergency or unexpected situation that arise from time to time.
- Supervise Transport Officers and Foreman Mechanic.
- Implement operational strategy, policies and procedures to ensure compliance laws/regulations.
- Maintain a physical presence to monitor work outcomes.
- Ensure that all relevant tests are administered to people/staff.
- Reconcile depot stocks daily.

- Managing all processes at the bus depot.
- Perform incident investigation activities.
- Promote Risk awareness by participating actively in the Risk Committee and work-shopping Operations staff on risk.
