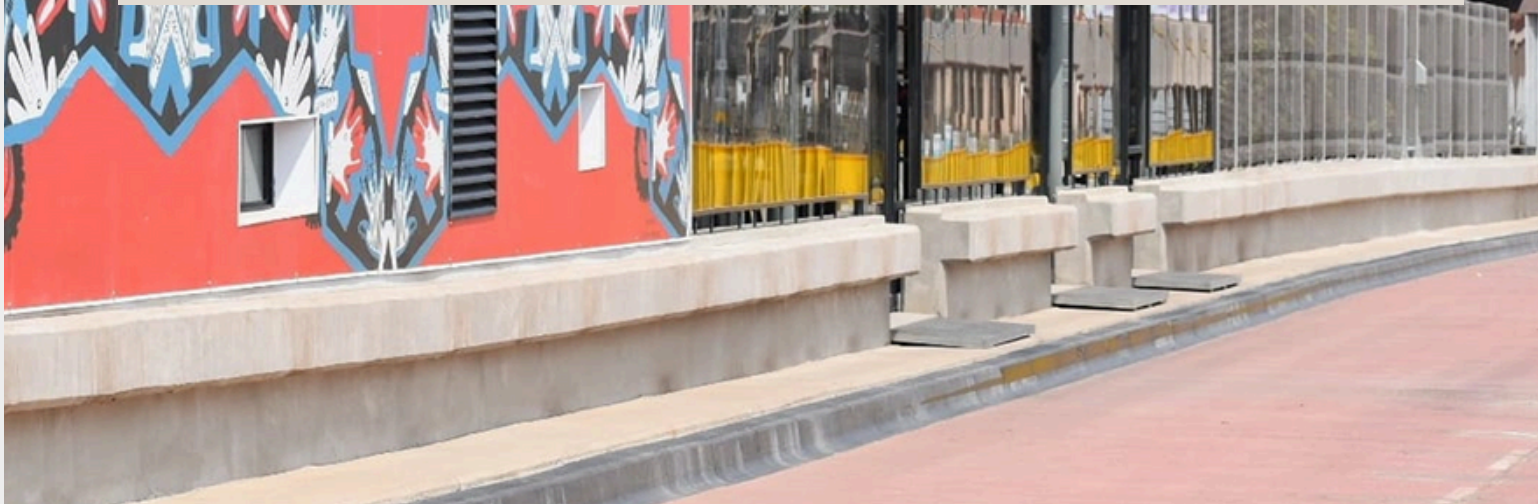
## **BUS STATION OPERATIONALISATION**

As KTVR, we commend the City of Ekurhuleni and the Ekurhuleni Taxi Industry for finalising and appointing a service provider to oversee the maintenance, security, and cleaning of the Harambee Bus Stations.

On Monday, 16 December 2024, the first three Bus Stations were operationalised and opened for passengers. The ticket-selling kiosks inside the stations were also operationalised, increasing the number of ticket-selling kiosks available to passengers.
