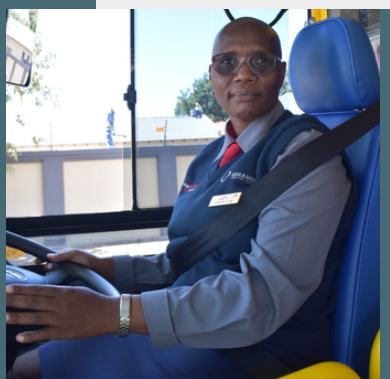
other BRT Vehicle Operating Companies across the country.
